Tuesday, April 9: Depart United States

Depart Washington, DC Dulles International Airport. Our non-stop flight includes meals, drinks and in-flight entertainment.

Wednesday, April 10: Arrive Cairo, Egypt, Tour of Pyramids

Arrive Cairo Airport. Our representative will meet and assist us through the airport formalities and obtaining a Visa. Transfer in a private A/C coach to the our hotel, where all of our deluxe rooms overlooking the Nile. Our rooms will be available although arriving in the early morning. Later in the morning, we start the tour of the three great **Giza Pyramids**, **Cheops**, **Chefren and Macarinos**. Gaze upon the **Great Sphinx**, which has kept its secrets for centuries, and the Valley Temple. Relax and refresh before **Welcome Dinner**.

Thursday, April 11: Tour of Cairo & The New Grand Egyptian Museum

After breakfast, we visit the **New Grand Museum** containing over 120,000 pieces of the Pharaonic Monuments and the brilliant collection of **Tutankhamon**. After lunch, we visit the iconic **Khan El Khalili Bazaar** and souk in the historic center of Cairo. The Khan is a vibrant open-air bazaar and treasure trove of Egyptian culture, with bustling streets filled with local artisans and vendors specializing in handmade masterpieces such as carpets, crystals, papyrus, gold and silver jewelry. Don't forget to haggle for the best bargains!

Friday, April 12: Tour of Abu Simbel, Nile Cruise Embarkation in Aswan

Simbel we visit the **Great Temple Hewn**, carved in rock, to marvel at the magnificent four colossal seated statues of **King Ramses** at the entrance of the Temple. The Temple is the most famous in all of Egypt after the Giza Pyramids. Built by the greatest of the pharaohs, Ramses II, these huge rock-cut temples marked the southern boundary of the Egyptian Empire with Nubia at the peak of its power during the New Kingdom. Depart Abu Simbel for flight to Aswan and enjoy lunch on board the luxury **Movenpick M/S Royal Lily Deluxe Cruise Ship.** Enjoy cruising the Nile in your spacious, deluxe river view staterooms, with floor-to-ceiling windows, exquisite cuisine, free internet and many other amenities. Saturday, April 13: Phiale Temple, Kom Ombo Temple

After breakfast, we visit the **Temple of Phiale**, dedicated to the Legend of **Isis** and **Osiris**. The temple walls contain scenes from Egyptiam mythology of Isis bringing Osiris back to life, giving birth to Horus and mummifying Osiris after his



death. Next stop is **the Kom Ombo**, unique because of its double design, meaning that all rooms were duplicated for two sets of gods. Half of the temple, **Temple of the Crocodile God Sobek**, was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, god of fertility. The other half was dedicated to the falcon god **Horus the Elder.** Tonight, enjoy the **Galabia Party** – dress in Egyptian outfits -- on board and strut like an Egyptian!

Sunday, April 14: Horus Temple & Temple of Luxor, East Bank

This morning, we explore the **Temple of Horus**, in the city of **Edfu**, a god in the form of a falcon whose right eye was the sun representing power, and left eye was the moon,

representing healing. The Temple is located in the city center and is considered the most impressive of all the Temples. After lunch, we sail to see the dramatic monuments of Luxor's East Bank and the **Temple of Luxor**, a complex located in the city known today as Luxor. Constructed over hundreds of year by Amenhotep III, Ramses II, Tutankhamun and other pharaohs, Luxor

Temple was the largest and most significant religious center in ancient Egypt.
