ITINERARY

Tuesday, January 19: Welcome to Bangkok

Arrive at Bangkok International Airport and meet your guide who will transfer you by private air-conditioned coach to the deluxe Pullman Bangkok Hotel G.

The remainder of the day is yours to relax or begin exploring the vibrant Thai capital at your own pace.

Wednesday, January 20: City Tour and Grand Palace; Dinner Cruise With Live Music and Show

After breakfast, we begin a fascinating introduction to Bangkok. Discover Bangkok's most magnificent temples and royal landmarks. Your journey begins at Wat Traimit, home to the world's largest solid gold Buddha statue, weighing an astonishing five and a half tons. Located near bustling Chinatown, the temple blends spiritual serenity with vibrant city life.

Continue to Wat Pho, one of Bangkok's oldest and largest temple complexes. Here you will see the breathtaking 46-metre Reclining Buddha, covered in gold leaf and surrounded by beautifully decorated chedis. The tour concludes at the spectacular Grand Palace, the historic heart of the Thai Kingdom. This dazzling complex of royal halls, courtyards, and temples once served as the residence of Thai kings.

Within the palace grounds you will also visit the revered Temple of the Emerald Buddha, one of Thailand's most sacred religious sites. Strict dress regulations apply at the Grand Palace:

- Shoulders must be covered
- No see-through clothing
- No dresses or skirts above the knee
- No shorts or sportswear

Appropriate clothing can be purchased near the palace entrance if needed.

Tonight, enjoy a magical evening cruising along the legendary Chao Phraya River.

Board the elegant Wonderful Pearl Cruise and be welcomed with a refreshing cocktail before setting sail.

As you glide through the heart of Bangkok, admire the illuminated skyline and historic landmarks shimmering along the riverbanks.

Pass iconic sights including:

- Wat Arun – the stunning Temple of Dawn
- The Grand Palace
- Wat Phra Kaew – Temple of the Emerald Buddha

A lavish Thai and international buffet dinner is served on board, complemented by a live band and traditional Thai dance performance. A special sushi corner also offers freshly prepared Japanese selections.

Choose between the open-air deck or the air-conditioned lounge as you soak in Bangkok's unforgettable night views.

Thursday, January 21: Damnoen Saduak Floating Market & Maeklong Railway Market

After an early breakfast, depart Bangkok for one of Thailand's most famous cultural experiences. Travel approximately 68 miles west of Bangkok to reach Damnoen Saduak, Thailand's most iconic floating market. Step back in time as you glide along narrow canals where local vendors paddle wooden boats loaded with fresh fruits, vegetables, snacks, and handmade goods. The vibrant atmosphere, colorful boats, and traditional wooden houses create a scene straight from another era. You will also visit the fascinating Maeklong Railway Market, where market stalls are set directly on the railway tracks. When the train

approaches, vendors swiftly retract their stalls—only to set them back up moments later once it passes. Return to Bangkok late morning.

The remainder of the day is free for independent exploration.

Friday, January 22: Bangkok By Night Tuk Tuk Adventure

After breakfast, enjoy a full day at leisure. Relax at your hotel, visit nearby shopping districts, or explore Bangkok's famous street markets.

As the city lights up, embark on an unforgettable nighttime Tuk-Tuk adventure through Bangkok's vibrant streets. A Tuk-Tuk is a 3-wheeled, open-air motorized vehicles.

Ride through bustling neighborhoods and discover the city's energy after dark as temples glow under dramatic lighting and markets come alive.

Highlights include:

- Nighttime visit to Wat Arun – the Temple of Dawn
- Exploration of Bangkok's colorful Flower Market
- Stops at lively local markets
- Authentic Thai dinner at a local restaurant
- Street-food tastings and dessert in Chinatown

Saturday, January 23: Pattaya, Sanctuary of Truth & Nong Nooch Tropical Garden

Depart early this morning for Pattaya, one of Thailand's most famous beach resort cities on the Gulf of Thailand, about 90 miles from Bangkok. It's also famous for its nightlife, especially the pedestrian nightlife strip called Walking Street. Enjoy three incredible sites! Explore one of the world's most impressive botanical gardens, home to more than 18,000 plant species. Nong Nooch is internationally renowned for its collections of rare palms, cycads, heliconias, bougainvillea, and other exotic plants.

During your visit you may also enjoy Traditional Thai cultural performances, The popular elephant show (subject to schedule) and a Scenic sightseeing bus ride through the expansive gardens.

A Thai buffet lunch will be served at a restaurant within the garden. In the afternoon, visit the remarkable Sanctuary of Truth, an enormous wooden temple constructed entirely from hand-carved teak wood.

Overlooking the sea, the structure is covered with intricate carvings that represent philosophical and spiritual themes inspired by various Asian traditions.

Afterward, enjoy some relaxing time at Pattaya Beach before returning to Bangkok.

Sunday, January 24: Day of Leisure

Today is completely free for you to enjoy Bangkok however you wish.

Some ideas include:

- Shopping at luxury malls or vibrant street markets
- Visiting rooftop bars with skyline views
- Exploring local neighborhoods and cafés
- Relaxing with a traditional Thai spa treatment
